



## School Booklists and School Costs 2019 to 2020

### Dear Families,

Please read the following carefully so that there is no misunderstanding what parents/guardians are required to purchase, what parents are required to pay to the school and what the school provides. This school is significantly reducing costs in a number of areas this year. This includes reviewing the booklists, stationary and copies. Therefore the overall cost to families should decrease. The school has reviewed the books to be purchased and more are now on the book rental scheme.

- The copies are now more streamlined with some copies being used over a two year band; e.g. 1<sup>st</sup> class to 2nd class. Your child (ren) will receive any unfinished / unused copies home this year. If you wish your child (ren) to use them next year please send them to school in September along with all other school supplies.

**Please ensure that you purchase the correct textbooks for your child (ren) for their class level.**

### Incoming junior infants:

Parents/guardians are required to purchase certain textbooks, copy books and stationary for their child (ren) and keep their child (ren) supplied with stationary throughout the school year.

### Senior infants, first class, second class, third class, fourth class, fifth class, sixth class

Parents/guardians are to purchase certain textbooks, stationary & copies and keep their child (ren) supplied with stationery throughout the school year.

The school costs continue to be significantly reduced this year at €60. All families of pupils in this school are to pay a fee of: €60:00 to the school (2 siblings €100, 3 siblings €140, 4 siblings €175)
